I write to express my concern regarding the prosecution by North Wales Crown Prosecution Service (CPS) of Anke Hill, Wilfred Wong, Janet & Edward Stevenson and various others for alleged kidnapping which allegedly occurred in Anglesey on the 4th of November 2020.

Anke Hill, who is the mother of 8 year old Sam Hill, the alleged kidnap victim, has long maintained that her ex-husband, Leslie Hill, together with various associates of his, had extensively and severely sexually abused Sam Hill. Anke has also described the nature of the abuse inflicted on her son as Satanist Ritual Abuse (SRA). Please note that the existence of Satanic Abuse in the UK has been officially acknowledged by the UK's oldest and largest police force, i.e. the Metropolitan Police Service (<https://www.met.police.uk/.../child-abuse/faith-based-abuse/>). There are also several successfully prosecuted SRA cases in the UK, which have been compiled into a list that is available on the internet (<https://casra.org.uk/prosecuted-cases/>). Please note that at least one of the successfully prosecuted SRA cases on this list occurred in Wales. It took place in Kidwelly, Wales and the Satanist Ritual abusers in that case were prosecuted and convicted in 2011.

About 2 years ago, Sam Hill revealed to his mother, Anke Hill, that he had been extensively sexually abused by his father Leslie, and some of his father's associates. Anke Hill has states that about 400 pages of notes were written regarding her son's disclosures of abuse. These disclosures indicate that the boy suffered SRA allegedly at the hands of his father and some of his father's associates.

Despite such extensive disclosures and the extremely serious nature of the alleged crimes, by Leslie Hill and some of his associates, so far there has been no thorough police investigation of this case and Social Services and family courts have been more interested in demonising and penalising Sam's whistleblowing mother, Anke Hill, and facilitating the handing over of Sam Hill to the legal custody of his alleged abuser, Leslie Hill.

About 2 years ago when Sam Hill revealed that he had been extensively sexually abused by his father, why did the police not take the boy's allegations seriously and fail to thoroughly investigate what he claimed?

Why did social services penalise Sam Hill's mother, Anke, for simply trying to get justice for her boy, by removing him from his mother's custody?

Contrast the above gross negligence regarding the welfare and safety of 8 year old Sam Hill with the extensive and robust efforts by the police and the CPS in North Wales to investigate and prosecute Anke Hill and all those who allegedly helped her snatch her son back from the grip of social services.

To make matters even worse, Social Services are likely to hand Sam Hill over to the legal custody of his father, Leslie Hill, in January 2021. And during his time in foster care, Social Services has arranged for Sam Hill to be extensively indoctrinated in order to convince him that he was never sexually abused by his father. Despite the fact that the police have never thoroughly investigated Sam Hill's allegations, Social Services have simply assumed that Sam's claims must be untrue. Who are the real kidnappers here? Sam Hill's mother, Anke Hill and her helpers, or Social Services?

Ironically, the police and CPS have used Sam Hill's testimony as part of their case against his mother, Anke Hill, and her co-defendants. It appears that the Police and CPS simply pick and choose when they wish to listen to Sam Hill and when to ignore his testimony.

I believe that it certainly does not serve the public interest and it would be very unjust to put Anke Hill, Wilfred Wong, Janet and Edward Stevenson and all the rest of Anke Hill's co-defendants on trial and to prosecute them. Instead, what the law enforcement authorities should be focusing on is investigating Sam Hill's extensive allegations of sexual abuse against his father, Leslie Hill, and some of his father's associates.

Such an investigation is especially urgently needed now as Sam Hill appears very likely to be handed over to the legal custody of his father in January 2021.

A thorough, proper police investigation is urgently needed now into Sam Hill's allegations of sexual abuse against his father. In addition an independent investigation into Social Services' disturbing role in this entire matter is also urgently needed.

All attempts to hand Sam Hill over to his father's custody must be stopped as such action is likely to put this young boy in very grave danger.

The trial of Anke Hill and all her co-defendants has been scheduled for the summer of 2021. Despite the trial date being several months away they have so far all been denied bail and been kept in prison. They are supposed to have a right to bail and to be presumed innocent until proven guilty. But the Welsh authorities have treated them as if they have already been proven guilty. I urge that Anke Hill, Wilfred Wong, Janet and Edward Stevenson and all of Anke's other co-defendants are granted bail now.

I urge you to do all you can to implement all my above mentioned requested actions. This is necessary to prevent a serious miscarriage of justice and to protect a very vulnerable child.
